Book Club brochures will be coming home with the children this week. This is the **last one** for the year, and the **due date is next Tuesday October 27th**.

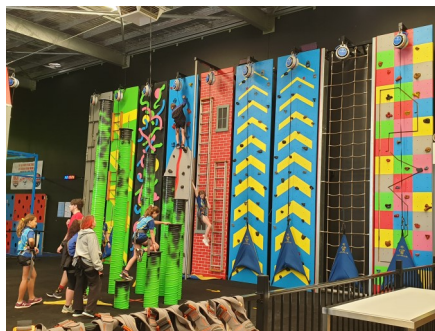
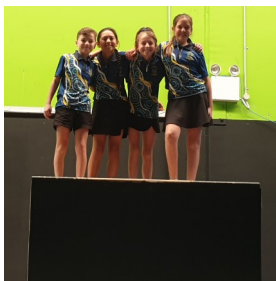
If ordering as a surprise for your child for a birthday or Christmas then please let the school know and we will hold the books in the office for your collection.

Mrs Beanland would like to thank everyone who has ordered this year.



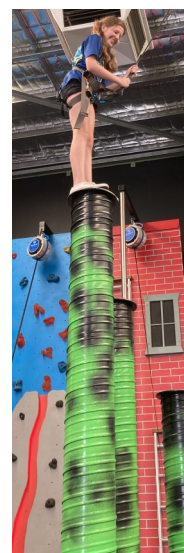
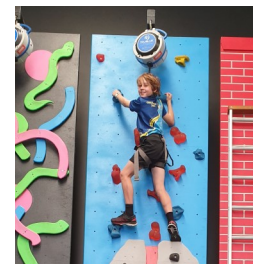
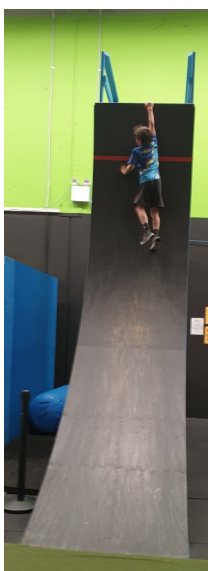
