Dear Parents and Caregivers

Grounds Improvement Committee: The school would like to draw up a master plan for improving the school grounds. Some projects could be immediate and others may be long term. We appreciate your co-operation in our endeavour to create a safe and harmonious environment for our students.

It will be in the morning with the exact time yet to be announced. All the students had fun and learnt new things about their local area. A big thank you to the parents that helped out on the day.
































































